

# International patient admission flowchart

Refer the patient to the international patient reception unit

Introducing the patient to the IPD specialist by the reception unit

Receiving the necessary documents and type of service from the patient by the IPD expert

Referral of the patient/company of the contracting party to receive health insurance for health tourism

Does the patient have health insurance?

Does the patient have a confirmation of not being infected with infectious diseases?

Does the patient have an infectious disease?

Contact the infectious disease doctor to inform about illness

Referral of the patient/company of the contracting party to receive confirmation of non-infection of infectious diseases

Does the patient need inpatient services?

Coordination with the outpatient service provider unit required by the IPD specialist

Visiting the patient with an IPD expert to receive the desired service

Accompanying the patient to the inpatient department and introducing her/him by the IPD

Patient admission in the ward

\*required documents

- ❖ Passport or passport of the country of origin
- ❖ Hospitalization order of the referring doctor (if any)
- ❖ Medical documents and records
- ❖ Authentic confirmation that the person does not suffer from IHR infectious diseases
- ❖ Health tourism insurance
